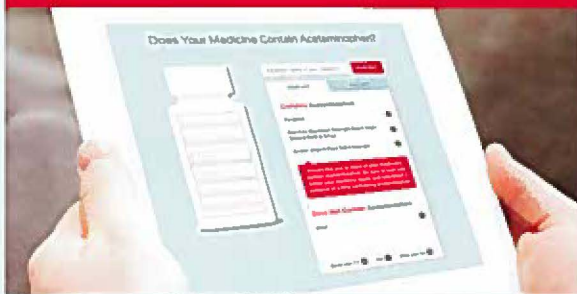

Get responsible relief when you take acetaminophen

Why it's important

- Acetaminophen is an active ingredient in **more than 600** over-the-counter and prescription medicines—including those used for dental pain relief.
- When taken as directed, acetaminophen is safe and effective. But if you take too much—more than 4,000 mg in a day—**you could harm your liver.**
- That's why it's so important to **always read and follow your medicine labels.**

Where to find acetaminophen on your medicine labels

On a prescription medicine label:

Look for the word "Acetaminophen," sometimes shortened to "APAP"



On an over-the-counter medicine label:

Look for the word "Acetaminophen" where it says "Active ingredient"
